

Literacy:

This term we will look at the story 'The Jolly Postman.' We will write our own version on the story and write and post our own letters.

This term we will have pen pals from Brampton Abbotts School and will be sending each other letters.

Topic work will encourage writing captions, labels, lists, instructions, role play, questions stories and poems. We will also be writing winter poems.

Maths:

We will be linking our maths to topic by measuring in the water and sand, linking height to fireman ladder and weighing parcels.
