### **After School Child Care – Spring Gate @ Bridstow Primary School Village Hall**

As part of our commitment to improve the provision at Bridstow CE Primary School, we have been working with Spring Gate Nursery School to provide after school care for children of Bridstow School.

This service will be on a trial basis to explore whether after school child care is financially feasible at Bridstow in the long-term. The trial will run from **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September until Friday 15<sup>th</sup> December**. By this time, I will be able to make an informed decision about whether the care will be able to be offered for the rest of the academic year and future years.

Spring Gate will offer the care on **Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 3.15pm until 5pm**. The cost of their after school care will be £6 per hour. There is a chance, that with a great enough uptake, this hourly fee could be reduced.

Spring Gate will be hiring Bridstow Village Hall for the purpose of running the after school care. They will collect your child from school at 3.15pm. They will also be offering care following on from our after school clubs that are held. School staff will take the children to the village hall when school clubs end. You will need to collect your child from the village hall on days when you use their care.

Should you wish to book your child in for after school care please make bookings via their email: [springgatenurseryschool@outlook.com](mailto:springgatenurseryschool@outlook.com) by Wednesday the week before the care is required. Should you have any further queries please contact Spring Gate Nursery directly on 01989 762862 or via their email address above.

This additional provision has been a long time coming at Bridstow and I hope that there will be sufficient numbers during the autumn term for it to be viable for this academic year and future years.
