Non-uniform day



We will be sending home 'snapshot' reports for KS1 and KS2 pupils in the final couple of weeks of the year in July. The snapshot reports are very brief summaries and will give a measure of your child's attainment in writing, reading and maths as well as a short 'learning summary' written by your child's teacher which will indicate your child's attitude to learning and progress.

There will be the option of brief meetings with teachers based on these reports.
